Sister Vickie Williams Named Our January 2019 Everyday Hero

Please join us recognizing Greater Mt. Nebo's first Everyday Hero of 2019, Sister Vickie Williams. Sister Vickie serves as the Coordinator/Head of our GMNEBO SHARE program, a role she has held since May 2014. For persons not familiar with SHARE, it's program run by a non-profit, community based organization that assists thousands of families each month with affordable, nutritious groceries that are sold through volunteer-run locations throughout the Washington/Baltimore metropolitan area including Greater Mt. Nebo. As coordinator of our SHARE Program, Sister Vickie collects orders, recruits, organizes and trains volunteers to bag and distribute food packages and directs payment to SHARE for orders received each month. Sister Vickie is being recognized this month not only for her outstanding work heading up this program, but also for her efforts that have expanded our specific program to aid families in need through donations and sponsorship. In 2018 alone, Sister Vickie collected more than \$9,020 making it possible for the distribution of an average of 42 value packages each month to families and seniors in our local community. Some of these same families, with a greater need to feed children in their care, received additional food donations during holidays and school breaks as a result of coordinated food drives personally orchestrated by Sister Vickie.
